Subject: Institutional Space Survey / Memo # AS-11-02

State and federal regulations require LSU to maintain an accurate inventory of space in all buildings owned or leased by the University. This information provides support to the University's requests for federal reimbursement, new construction, and renovation project funding. The space inventory also provides a basis for reimbursement to LSU through the Facilities and Administrative (F&A) cost rate.

As required by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-21, regulations that govern the University's calculation of the F&A rate, the Office of Accounting Services will undertake a campus-wide space survey. University space will be divided into two survey cycles; Cycle A (FY 2011) and Cycle B (FY 2012). The detailed cycle schedule is attached to this letter. The project will take place over a two year period commencing in November 2010.

During the space surveys, the following information will be documented:

- Room utilization (i.e. sponsored research, instruction, administration, etc)
- Occupants for rooms designated as sponsored research
- Account numbers associated with space used for <u>sponsored research</u>
- Room type (i.e. office, laboratory, conference room, etc)

Members of the space survey team will begin contacting departmental representatives to schedule surveys for Cycle A space. An individual with knowledge of the department's space inventory, room occupants, and room usage should be present during the survey. The survey team will not need to walk through departmental space unless issues arise in comparing floor plans to actual space. Meetings can last from thirty minutes to two hours – depending on the size and complexity of the department. Multiple meetings may be necessary for departments with a large volume of sponsored agreements.
