Project Goals

- Replace legacy physical Tiger Card Student ID
 - Transition from card swipe tracks to a Near Field Communication (NFC) Standard.
 - A Mobile Credential compatible with iOS and Android devices will be standard options.
 - We have a plan in place.
- Standardization of all physical access control systems on campus, including biometrics
 - The centralized physical access control system will be compatible with the Tiger Card Mobile Credential.
 - We are working on a plan.

Traditional physical door keys and locks are out of scope for this project. Only LSU[A&M] main campus is in scope for this project.

LSU Major Risks: Call to Action



- All current Tiger Card usage by the LSU Community must be identified usage not known by the project will cease working once Go-Live for Tiger Card Mobile Credential occurs.
- Although funding source is not yet identified, the goal is that the one-time cost of the project will be covered centrally. The project recognizes high cost of replacing *current* mechanisms (in some cases running power, network connectivity, replacing controllers, and recurring costs to adhere to Near Field Communication standards.)
- There will be a single vendor for physical security access all other solutions will be deprecated.
- Ensuring proper handling of physical security access during power outages across campus.

Benefits

- Enhanced Technology. Surpassing industry standard encryption for technologies including Bluetooth.
- Mobility. LSU community will have convenient access to TigerCASH, Paw Points, Meal Plans, and Door Access.
- Local Management. Departments will be able to manage Physical Access Control Systems throughout departmental spaces easily and with a single solution.
- Student Requested. LSU's adoption of a mobile credential is responsive to student needs and aligns with peer institutions.
- Public Safety. Central auditing will ensure only authorized, active faculty, staff, and students may access
 restricted areas.
