MAJOR & CAREER EXPLORATION

Career Assessment

Require students to take the free Focus2 assessment. Students receive results immediately and the LSU OCC is able to provide a group interpretation during class.

Connecting Coursework to Career

Collaborate with the LSU OCC to present to your course at the beginning or end of the semester to discuss the career competencies incorporated within the lectures and assignments.

Require students to write a short reflection on exploring their major or career field. Suggested methods for exploration include:

- Review "What Can I Do With This Major?", the Occupational Outlook Handbook, and the O*NET, all available on the LSU OCC website.
- Conduct informational interviews with professionals in their career field of interest.
- Attend the Career Expo or another LSU OCC recruiting event to meet with employer partners.
