Installation

- <u>JC 1</u>: Cut all holes cleanly and no more than 1 inch larger than the penetrating object.
- <u>JC 2</u>: Air seal plumbing penetrations between conditioned and unconditioned space. Use fire-rated sealants where applicable.
- <u>JC 3:</u> For walls that will not have an interior finish and are separating conditioned and unconditioned spaces, insulate wall cavities and install an interior air barrier.
- <u>JC 4</u>: Hot water pipes must be insulated to R-2 when required.

JC 1: Cut all holes cleanly and no more than 1 inch larger than the penetrating object.

JC 3: For walls that will not have an interior finish and are separating conditioned and unconditioned spaces, insulate wall cavities and install an interior air barrier. RECOMMENDED: rigid air barrier.
