To the members of Acacia Fraternity,

Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Acacia Fraternity, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

10.2 Alcohol -- Responsible10.2 Violating a Rule of the University -- Responsible

As a result of the incidents that occurred on February 3, 2023, where Acacia Fraternity held a social event at their on-campus house and multiple components of PS-78 were violated, this Enhancement Plan will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Student Advocacy & Accountability:

Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective March 2, 2023 through May 31, 2024. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning could be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

- 1. Acacia leadership will read this letter in its entirety to the chapter with their advisor present by March 15, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by March 15, 2023.
- 2. Acacia will hold a leadership retreat for executive officers and judicial board members hosted by their advisor and headquarters staff by March 18, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of this retreat to SAA by March 18, 2023.
- 3. Acacia will host a risk management presentation with staff from LSU Greek Life focusing on an understanding of PS-78 by April 21, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by April 21, 2023.
- 4. Acacia will host a drugs and alcohol training with staff from Acacia by April 21, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by April 21, 2023.
- 5. Acacia will host a sober monitor training with staff from LSU Greek Life and SAA by April 21,

2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by April 21, 2023.6. Acacia must complete the risk management presentation, drugs and alcohol training, and sober monitor training before they are permitted to host any social events.

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the <u>online reporting form</u> or via email to <u>amaxwell@lsu.edu</u>.

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
