Dear Alpha Tau Omega,

Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

10.2 Alcohol -- Responsible10.2 Violating a Rule of the University -- Responsible

As a result of the incident that occurred on April 1, 2023, where Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity served prohibited alcohol at their off-campus Formal in New Orleans and components of PS-78 were violated, your organization has submitted an Enhancement Plan. This will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Student Advocacy & Accountability:

Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective May 10, 2023 through May 31, 2024. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning will be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

- 1. Alpha Tau Omega leadership will read this letter in its entirety to the chapter with their advisor present by September 1, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by September 1, 2023.
- 2. Alpha Tau Omega will host a Risk Management Presentation with staff from LSU Greek Life focusing on an understanding of PS-78 by September 15, 2023. The chapter will provide proof of at least 90% attendance to SAA by September 15, 2023.
- 3. Alpha Tau Omega must complete any additional outcomes assigned by the Fraternity and provide proof of these completed outcomes to SAA.
- 4. Alpha Tau Omega must complete their Risk Management Presentation and any additional outcomes assigned by the Fraternity before they are permitted to host any social events.

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the <u>online reporting form</u> or via email to Kyrsti Wyatt,

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcomes will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
