Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Sigma Nu Fraternity, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

10.2 Coercive Behavior -- Responsible

As a result of the incidents that occurred during Fall 2019, where Sigma Nu Fraternity new members set up tailgates, completed chores and went outside of the chapter's submitted New Member Education plan, your organization has submitted an Enhancement Plan. This will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Greek Life/Campus Life and Student Advocacy & Accountability:

Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective April 15, 2020 through May 31, 2021. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning could be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

1. Chapter will develop and implement a new cleaning program for the chapter facility to include all members submitted to SAA by July 1, 2020. A draft of the program will be shared with Sigma Nu Headquarters and Greek Life for review and feedback.
2. Chapter will develop and implement a chapter tailgate set-up plan for home football games to include all members submitted to SAA by August 15, 2020. A draft of the program will be shared with SN Headquarters and Greek Life for review and feedback.
3. The executive committee will complete the Sigma Nu Governance and Accountability Action Plan to address member participating issues. The plan will be submitted to SAA and Greek Life by July 1, 2020.
4. Executive committee will develop an officer transition program to be submitted to SAA and Greek Life by October 31, 2020.
5. Chapter will add a Co-Candidate Marshal so that responsibilities for position are split between two officers. Responsibilities will be updated for Candidate Marshal Committee too. Position descriptions submitted to SAA and Greek Life by July 1, 2020.
6. SN Headquarters staff will present Chapter Enhancement Plan and Sigma Nu's program "A Different Look at Hazing" with 80% member attendance. Agenda and attendance to be submitted to SAA by September 30, 2020.

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the [online reporting form](#) or via email to [REDACTED]

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability within the Office of the Dean of Students. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
