Retention of Scholarship:

Upon recommendation of the faculty, recipient may retain scholarship for additional years. The scholarship shall terminate when the recipient receives the undergraduate degree.

Withdrawal of Scholarship:

The scholarship shall be withdrawn for any of the following reasons:

- Disciplinary probation.
- Failure to maintain the required GPA
- Resigning or "dropping out" of the university.
- Failure to maintain full time status majoring in a Romance language.
