### IV. Voting

# V. New Business

a. SACSCOC Update

Non-compliant on 11 of 72 standards. Nothing ILC related was found non-compliant. SACS will re-review during on site visit in April. They will look at noncompliance standards and then pull 20 of the 72 standards to review.

b. ILC Proficiency Focus Group Schedule

ILC committee members will not oversee the sessions. There will be one person overseeing every session to take notes and bring back to the committee. All instructors teaching an ILC course will be invited rather than only the course coordinators. The focus groups are capped at 12.

c. Employer Perception Data

Discussion about Employer Perception Data, how employer's view students' career readiness and the value of higher education in preparing students for careers. Looked at traits considered very important by employers. Many are ILC proficiencies or embedded in the proficiencies. Discussed the gap between skills considered very important by employers and percentage of students perceived to be very prepared in that skill.

### d. Course Impact Review Template

Renewal of ILC courses required every 5 years. The first four ILC courses are up for review. It was decided to use these courses as a pilot for what the template and process will look like. The four coordinators of these courses will be invited to the next FS ILC committee meeting.

Held an initial discussion about what will review look like and what "success" means. There was a suggestion that we compare results with original proposal. Looked at what other schools ask for. Enrollment, syllabus, teacher evaluation results, plans for development and ongoing improvement to a course, grade distribution, student evaluation responses to ILC specific questions. General consensus that the review process is a good time to ask what is working and what is not working. It is an opportunity to review original proposal and consider what changes should be made.
