Faculty Senate Resolution 00-04 (Revised)

Whereas admission standards have changed at Louisiana State University (LSU); and

Whereas LSU still wanted to respond to adult education needs; and

Whereas the Admissions, Standards, and Honors Committee (ASH) has carefully and diligently considered the PASS program;

Therefore, be it resolved that the LSU Faculty Senate endorses the following changes to the PASS program:

- 1. PASS students must be a minimum of 25 years old.
- 2. No student will be admitted to PASS who is down more than 48 quality points.
- 3. Transcripts will be required, and quality point deficits determined for all prospective PASS students.
- 4. PASS students will be required to adhere to the admissions deadlines set by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. PASS students applying after the deadlines will be assessed a late fee. The deadline for admission, the transcript requirement, and the minimum age will be waived for students who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university.
- 5. The name of PASS be changed to LSU25+.
- 6. These changes will become effective in the Fall of 2000.
