Resolution 01-10 BOR consult with Chancellor and Faculty concerning admissions

March: First Reading, Rules Suspended, Passed Presented by Senator Martin Feldman

Whereas, the future of LSU is critically dependent upon the quality of the students it admits, and

Whereas, the faculty has traditionally addressed the extremely complex procedure of selection of students based on academic achievements, special talents, life and career experience, membership in groups underrepresented in the student body, and recommendations, and

Whereas, the LSU Board of Supervisors By-Laws Section (1-2-2) state that the faculty "shall establish curricula, fix standards of instruction, determine requirements for degrees, and generally determine educational policy, subject to the authority of the Board,"

Therefore, the Faculty Senate resolves that it is essential to the future of LSU that any decisions concerning admission procedures to LSU A&M made by the Board of Regents be made in close consultation with the Chancellor and the faculty or their representatives.
