## Revised version

*Whereas*, Governor Foster and the Legislature increased salaries for educators in Louisiana, providing in particular a 7.1% salary increase for faculty on his campus; and

*Whereas*, Governor Foster and the Legislature worked to stabilize the State Group Benefits Program; and

*Whereas*, Governor Foster and the Legislature increased targeted funding to institutions of higher education in the State, providing in particular to this campus

\$9.0 million in one-time matching funds for endowed chairs and professorships,
\$7.0 million for the Information Technology Initiative,
\$3.5 million in one-time funding for library acquisitions and equipment needs,
\$3.1 million to pay a portion of unfunded mandates,

as well as substantial additional funding for the Reilly Center for Media and Public Affairs, the Louisiana Geological Survey, and the School of Veterinary Medicine;

*Therefore*, the Faculty Senate of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College acknowledges and thanks Governor Foster and the members of the Legislature for their support of higher education.

*Further*, we look forward to their continued support and further investments in education. We share the view of our state leaders that a better quality of life for Louisiana citizens can be achieved through an emphasis on educational institutions. We believe that such investments will be a vital part of Louisiana's future.
