## **FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 80-05**

That Faculty Senate Resolution 79-08 be rescinded,

- 2. That graduation with Latin honors ("Cum Laude," "Magna Cum Laude," and "Summa Cum Laude") be awarded separately from graduation "With College Honors,"
- 3. That students with grade point averages of at least 3.70, 3.80, and 3.90 become eligible for graduation "Cum Laude," "Magna Cum Laude," and "Summa Cum Laude," respectively,
- That each college and school begin to develop a coherent program of honors education and submit the proposed program to the Vice-Chancellor for Academic Affairs by September 1, 1983, and

That students who will have completed these approved programs of honors education become eligible for graduation "With College Honors," a designation which will be recorded on the students' transcripts.
