

FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 88-17 (Amended)

WHEREAS the Admissions, Standards, and Honors (ASH) Committee of the Faculty Senate is charged "to recommend policies and standards concerning admission requirements of LSU," and

WHEREAS this charge was established at a time when LSU had open admissions for new Louisiana resident freshmen, and thus is insufficient for the current policies of restrictive admissions, and

WHEREAS exceptions to the admissions requirements are presently conducted by applying a set of rules covering waiver of specific course requirements for admissions, with the ASH Committee serving as a board for hearing appeals of admissions decisions not covered by those rules'

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an Undergraduate Admissions Committee be established, consisting of a subcommittee within ASH and comprised of the Chairman of ASH, two additional members of ASH, the Dean of the Division of Academic Services, and the Director of the Office of Admissions. The charges to this committee are (1) to hear and approve or deny all applications for exceptions to the admissions requirements in accordance with established admissions policies; (2) to meet annually with the Athletic Director and other interested parties to inform them of the admissions requirements and related developments; and (3) to provide a summary report of admissions and exceptions to the admissions requirements at meetings of the Faculty Senate.
