FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 88-20

WHEREAS the Faculty Senate Admissions, Standards, and Honors Committee has received a petition to make an exception to the rule that courses on which a student has declard "Academic Bankruptcy" be included in the average when eligibility for University Honors is considered, and

WHEREAS a previous AS&H Committee granted a similar request in 1985, and

WHEREAS a student "starting over" should be provided the same opportunities and incentives to excel as a more traditional student, and

WHEREAS the current AS&H Committee can find no reason to continue this aspect of the Academic Bankruptcy regulations;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that courses declared void under Academic Bankruptcy regulations should <u>not</u> be considered when eligibility for University honors is determined, and that this change be implemented immediately.
